ARTICLE IV. CASUAL SALES

Sections:

14-113 SALES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON SUNDAY OR ON A HOLIDAY.
Casual sales shall be permitted for no more than three consecutive days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

14-115 No signs advertising a casual sale shall be placed within a public right-of-way (this includes utility poles). Right-of-ways are typically 66' from the center of the road. Along Whitehall Road it's 75' from the center of the road.

Signs advertising such sales shall not be placed on the sale premises more than 24 hours before the sale and shall be promptly removed after.

14-134 No person shall be eligible to obtain a permit more than twice during any calendar year.

Casual sales are not permitted in the area between Eimer and First Streets, Bear Lake and Muskegon Lake during any community event.

14-136 A copy of the permit shall be posted in a prominent place during the period the sale is conducted.

NOTE: The above excerpt from Article IV does not reflect the complete Ordinance.

TEMPORARY SIGNS:

- Only one (1) temporary sign shall be permitted on a lot or parcel.
- No sign shall be closer than five (5) feet from any property line fronting a public street.
- Any signs placed in the right-of-way will be removed and destroyed by a police officer/City staff.

Violating these rules constitute a municipal civil infraction and are subject to a fine of not less than \$50.
